

How Does The Sunlight Gets To The Earth?

How Do We Record Sunshine

To record the sunshine we use an instrument called a Campbell-Stokes Recorder to record sunshine. It has a spherical lens which is quite like a crystal ball. There is also a cardboard strip. The suns rays focus on the cardboard

strip.
