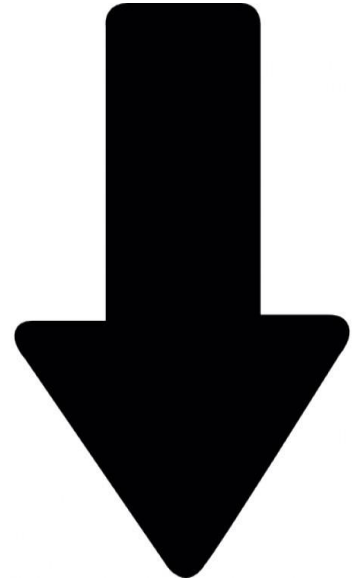


This is a Man Of

good but too much is raising the temperature. Fossil fuels are one problem but animals eat plants and release carbon dioxide into the atmosphere and the water.



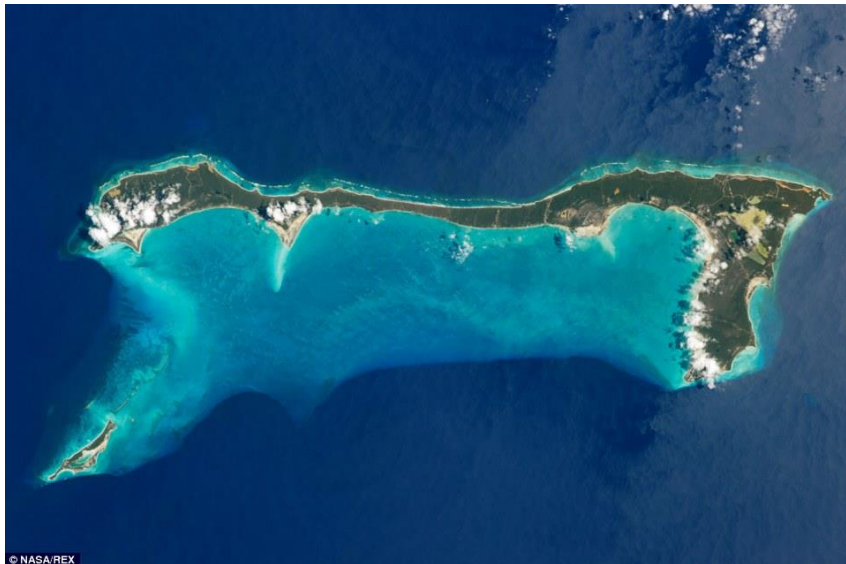

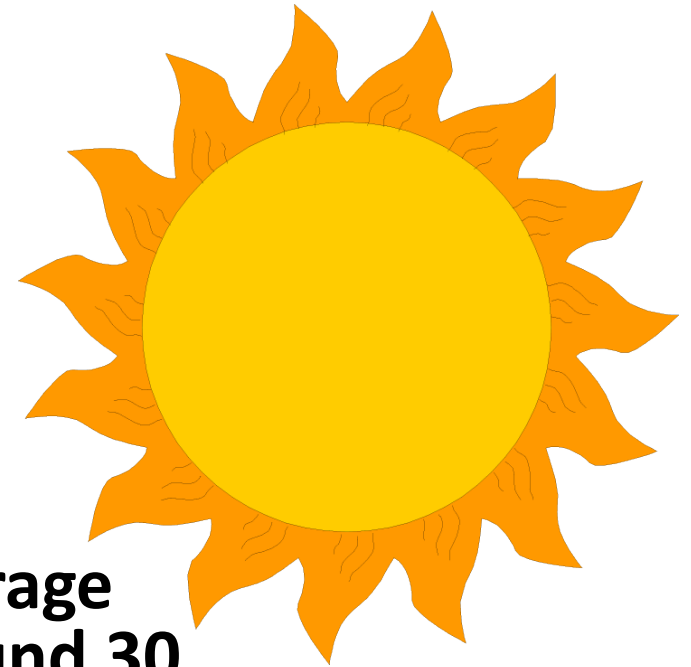
